Selection Procedure

Common Entrance Test:

Part A – Civil Services Aptitude Test 100 Marks 50 Questions
Part B – General Studies 100 Marks 40 Questions
CSAT is a qualifying Examination, where the student is required to score a minimum of 33% marks (33 out of 100).

• Interview 50 Marks

Scheme and Facilities Provided by the Higher Education Department, Government of Maharashtra

1. Facilities for the Students

- Free Coaching: Students are provided free coaching for Preliminary Examination and Mains by expert mentors.
- Library Facility: Library and reading room facility is provided to students.
- **Stipend:** Students are given stipend of **Rs. 4000 p.m.** during the period of training subject to min. attendance of 75%.
- Wi-fi Facility: Students are provided with wi-fi facility on the premises.
- Hostel Facility: Free hostel facility is provided to outstation students.
- Virtual Classroom: SIAC has a facility of virtual classroom where are lectures are recorded and made available to students.
- Computer Lab: Students are provided access to computer lab.

2. Special Scholarship Scheme - I

- Year: 2016
- Objective: To increase number of candidates qualifying UPSC examination from Maharashtra.
- Eligibility: Students who have cleared Mains and reached till interview stage but did not qualify for the final selection during the last three years.
- Facilities: Free coaching in reputed private coaching centre at Delhi and monthly stipend of Rs. 10000.

• **Scheme:** Test Series from reputed private coaching institute is provided to candidates.
