Dr. Abdul Kalam attended Saint Joseph's College Tiruc'hirappalli, graduating with a degree in physics in 1954. He then moved to Madras in 1955 to study aerospace engineering. After graduating from the Madras Institute of Technology in 1960, he joined the Aeronautical Development Establishment of the Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO) as a scientist. At DRDO in 1965, Dr. Abdul Kalam started work on an expandable rocket project independently, which was expanded in 1969, under government approval, to include more engineers. Also in 1969, Dr. Abdul Kalam was

transferred to the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) where he was the project director of India's first indigenous Satellite Launch Vehicle (SLV-III), which successfully deployed the Rohini satellite in near earth orbit in July 1980.
